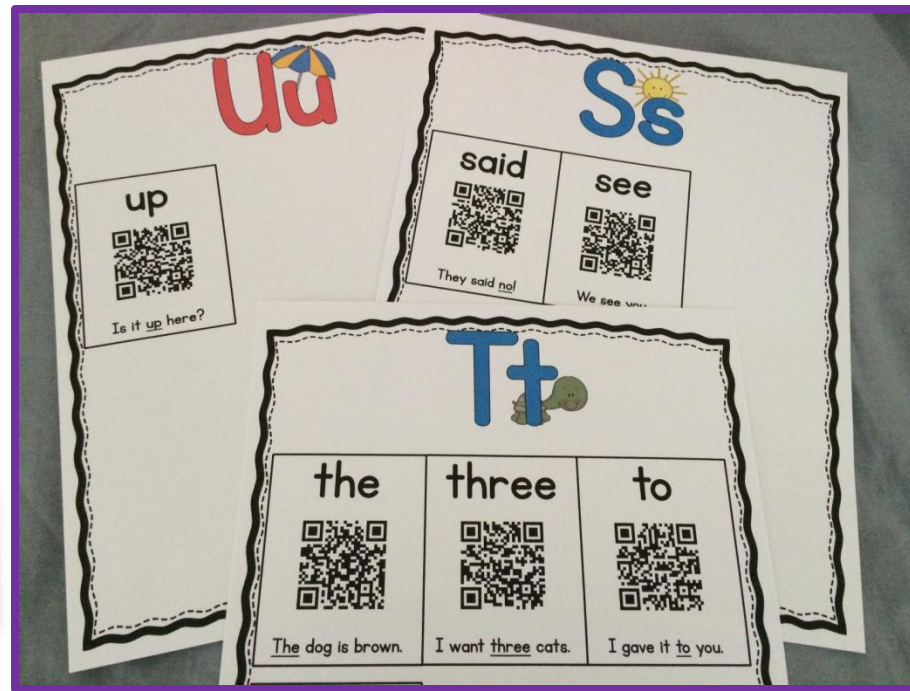

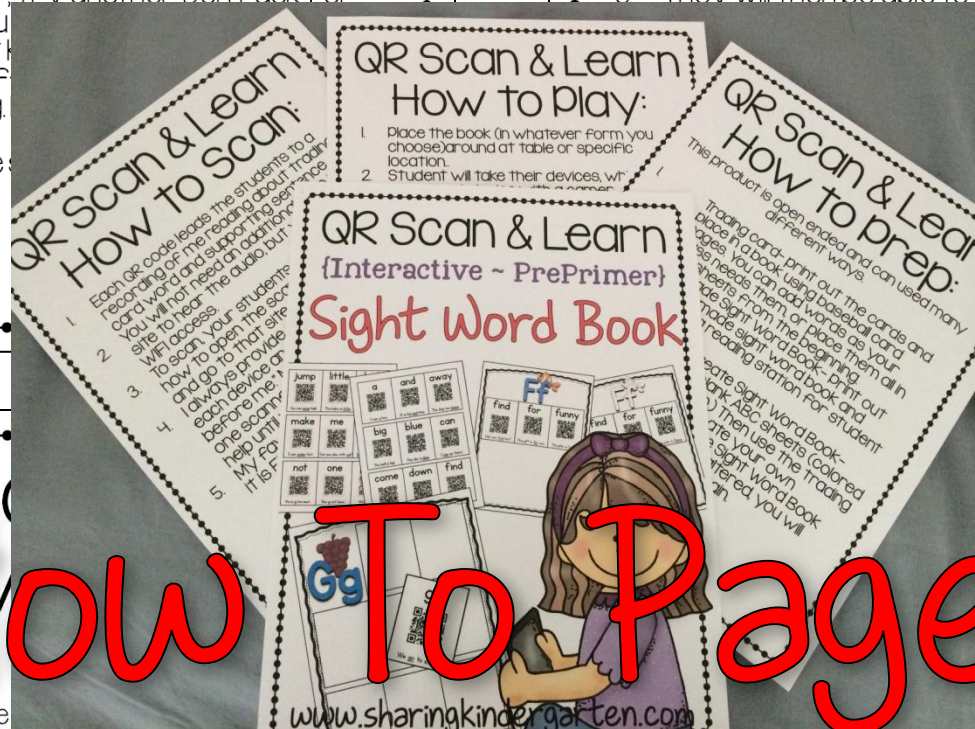

QR Scan & Learn How to Scan:

1. Each QR code leads the students to a recording of me reading about trading card word and supporting sentence.
2. You will not need an additional log in to any site to hear the audio, but you will need WIFI access.
3. To scan, your students will need to know how to open the scanner, scan the code, and go to that site.
4. I always provide a few QR readers on each device and have the rule, "Scan 3 before me." Meaning, if it doesn't work on one scanner, try another. Don't ask for help until you have scanned 3. PLUS-I don't have a scanner buffer, so it's not frustrating, it's a quick way to go.
1. My favorite: it is FREE.

QR Scan & Learn How to Play:

1. Place the book (in whatever form you choose) at a table or specific location that students can access easily.
2. Student will take their devices, which is any smart device with a camera function and wifi.
3. When they come to a sight word they don't know, they will scan the QR code
4. They will to HEAR that sight word being read to them, with a supporting sentence. Each audio is only a few seconds long, so they may need to hear it a few times.
5. They will then be able to read the sight word.



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QR Scan & Learn How to Prep:

3. Learn and Create

blank ABC sheets (colored and B&W version). Then use the trading card sheet to create your own versatile interactive Sight Word Book. This is ideal for those students who struggle with the same sight words.



Please Note: If the QR codes get altered, you will need to PRINT them again. I do not recommend laminating anything with a QR code on it since the glare can cause problems.

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QR Scan & Learn How to Prep:
